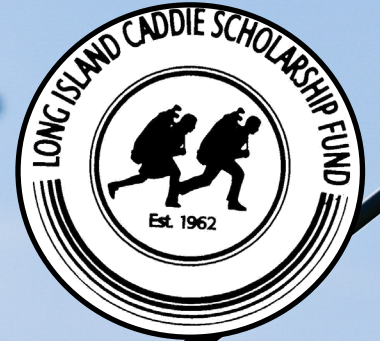

2023 LICSF EVENTS

The 12th annual Long Island Caddie Scholarship Fund Golf Marathon was held at Brookville Country Club in September under beautiful sunny skies.

A small group of participants started the day at 8 a.m. to play as many holes as possible to support the LICSF. A total of 436 holes were played. The golfers combined to play over 24 rounds of golf during the one-day event.

Nick Roden, representing the USGA, played 120 holes, a new record by one person for the Marathon.

In total, the golfers raised over \$62,000. The total grew as the pledges were calculated and additional funds were collected. This total set a new record for funds raised from the event. The Marathon has increased its fundraising total in each of the last three years.

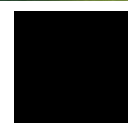

Youth caddieing is making a comeback on Long Island and across the Met Area, with 300 kids attending the MGA Foundation caddie academies in the spring of 2023.


The local caddie scholarship funds, both the LICSF and MGACSF, are working towards expanding on this success and growing the number of kids working in service to golf.
